Former Ladera Ranch Male Convicted of Serial Rape

Ali Achekzai (above), 33, formerly of Ladera Ranch, suspected of being an international serial rapist, was convicted December 15 of sexually assaulting three Southern California women.

He was captured in Austria in 2010 following a DNA match through INTERPOL. He was featured on the Orange County District Attorney's (OCDA) Most Wanted list.

He was found guilty by a jury of two felony counts of forcible rape, two felony count of sexual penetration by foreign object by force, one felony count of aggravated assault, one felony count of assault with the intent to commit a sexual offense, and sentencing enhancements and allegations for committing sexual crimes against more than one victim and causing great bodily injury to a victim.

He faces a maximum sentence of 80 years to life in state prison at his sentencing January 27.
